

Taxpayer Consent to Use Tax Return Information Pursuant to Treasury Regulation §301.7216-3(a)

Internal Revenue Code §7216 generally prohibits any person who is engaged in the business of preparing U.S. income tax returns from releasing information furnished to that individual for the preparation of any such return. Treasury Reg. §301.7216-3(a)(1) provides that such tax return information can be used if written consent of the taxpayer is obtained. This document is intended to provide written consent to use your tax return information for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your return.
